First Reading: Isaiah 61:1-2. 10-11 A reading from the prophet Isaiah

I exult for joy in the Lord.

The spirit of the Lord has been given to me, for the Lord has anointed me. He has sent me to bring good news to the poor, to bind up hearts that are broken; to proclaim liberty to captives, freedom to those in prison; to proclaim a year of favour from the Lord.

'I exult for joy in the Lord, my soul rejoices in my God, for he has clothed me in the garments of salvation, he has wrapped me in the cloak of integrity, like a bridegroom wearing his wreath, like a bride adorned in her jewels.

'For as the earth makes fresh things grow, as a garden makes seeds spring up, so will the Lord make both integrity and praise spring up in the sight of the nations.

'Responsorial Psalm: My soul rejoices in my God..

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; he sent me to bring Good News to the poor. Alleluia!

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8 A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

Make straight the paths of the Lord.

The beginning of the Good News about Jesus Christ, the Son of God. It is written in the book of the prophet Isaiah: Look, I am going to send my messenger before you; he will prepare your way. A voice cries in the wilderness: Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight, and so it was that John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. All Judaea and all the people of Jerusalem made their way to him, and as they were baptised by him in the river Jordan they confessed their sins. John wore a garment of camel-skin, and he lived on locusts and wild honey. In the course of his preaching he said, 'Someone is following me, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to kneel down and undo the strap of his sandals. I have baptised you with water, but he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit.

ADVENT REFLECTIONS BOOKS FOR SALE "With Expectant Hearts" is a 22-day reflection resource for Advent during the 2023-2024 liturgical year. Each day's reflection is inspired by a short text of scripture, and concludes with a thought or two to take away and with a prayer. This Advent resource invites us to explore more deeply what it means to allow God to come to birth in us. "With Expectant Hearts" aims to help us enter a new liturgical year, the journey of faith that stretches before us. Advent is the God-given time to revisit the challenge and to deepen our understanding of what it means for us both communally and individually. Books are now available to purchase for \$6. They are in the sacristies of both churches (cash only and an honesty system is in place) or you can visit the parish office during operating hours.

PARISH OFFICE CHRISTMAS CLOSURE The parish office will close on Friday 22 December and will reopen on Monday 15 January for limited hours. Normal office hours will resume on Monday 29 January. During the office closure Fr John will be contactable for end of life anointing and funeral arrangements on our after-hours answering service. 2024 SACRAMENT DATES AND RE PROGRAMME Our Sacrament dates for 2024 have now been set with the first being the Sacrament of First Reconciliation taking place in late March. Applications are now open for our RE Programme and the course going ahead will depend on enrolment numbers. Our RE Programme is held at St Therese's and is open to children from both parishes. The programme for First Reconciliation begins on Sunday 3 March and concludes with the Reconciliation Service on Wednesday 27 March. Enrolments for this first programme close on Friday 23 February.
